

The ROOT and MedShr

<u>RCSLT Online Outcome Tool (ROOT)</u> users may be interested in joining discussions on Therapy Outcome Measure cases on <u>MedShr</u>, covering a spectrum of issues within rehabilitation. <u>MedShr</u> is a HIPAA and GMC compliant platform that enables healthcare professionals and doctors to share and discuss clinical cases with over 600,000 members in 180+ countries.

You can also share your own therapy and rehabilitation cases on <u>MedShr</u>. Simply join the <u>Therapy Outcome Measure Rehabilitation Group</u> and upload your cases to discuss key topics with colleagues. Cases need only a short description and are usually accompanied by a clinical photo or image, but this is not essential. You must ensure that cases are anonymized so that there is no patient identifiable information on the case or images.

MedShr is free to use and available from the App Store or Google Play. You can also register on the website.

Some trending cases in the group on MedShr are:

- How would you rate Mrs PR's multiple sclerosis rehabilitation using Therapy Outcome Measure?
- This 75-year-old patient recently had a stroke. What is your assessment using TOMs?
- What is your TOM rating for this 6-year-old with suspected autistic spectrum disorder?
